First published over thirty years ago and still widely referenced even though it has been out of print for some years, Edward Relph's *Place and Placelessness* has taken its place as a classic of the phenomenological approach to the study of place and has influenced a generation of scholars by its insights: insights presented with unusual clarity and precision.
